Call to Order

Roll Call

John McGovern then called roll. All members of the board were present.

Approve/Amend Agenda Items

The board reviewed the agenda for the June 21, 2203 meeting. Pastor Robert Franseen moved to approve the agenda. John McGovern seconded the motion and the board voted in favor 8-0.

Visitor Introductions

Ken Honeck welcomed in-person and virtual visitors to the meeting.

Approval of Minutes

Nic Reisenberg made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 17, 2023 meeting. John McGovern seconded the motion and the board voted in favor 8-0.

Finance Report

Bruce Culley gave an overview of the financial report for May 2023. Sales tax revenue in May 2023 totaled \$868,719.09, a 4.73 % increase compared to May 2022. The total fund balance as of May 31, 2023 was \$15,045,477.97, with \$9,086,973.70 in total grants committed. Revenue in May 2023 totaled \$883,752.70 and expenses totaled \$1,499,074.78, for a total net operating revenue in May 2023 of (\$615,322.08). With a motion by Rick Jones and a second by John McGovern, the board voted to approve the financial report as presented 8-0.

Executive Director's Report

Kathy Macken shared the following approved budget revisions requests:

- LevelUp Kids reallocated \$25,468.04 from program supplies to continuing education and to support additional hours for staff.
- Mattie Rhodes reallocated \$3,000 from staff training, mileage and CEO salary, to support a fulltime bilingual service coordinator salary.
- The Family Conservancy reallocated \$81,736.47 from prevention staff, to support Summer Community Conscious Discipline Training Event and Play Therapist salaries.

Next, she shared that the submitted community-based service application total \$14,199,529 in requested funds. The Programs Committee is currently reviewing the requested, with decisions anticipated to be made at the July CSF meeting.

Action Items

Pastor Robert Franseen shared recommendations for approval on behalf of the Programs Committee.

With a motion by John McGovern and a second by Ken Honeck, the board voted to approve the following 2022-23 budget revision recommendation for Excelsior Springs Hospital:

• The Excelsior Springs Hospital was able to attain HRSA status and does not need to buy out the contract for Sean West, as previously approved by the board. The \$110,000 will be reallocated for salary expenses in the growing program.

With a motion by John McGovern and a second by Bruce Culley, the board voted to approve the 2023-24 budget revision recommendation for North Kansas City School District:

 Increase the budget by \$171,660, for a total award amount of \$3,559,210, providing a balance of \$277,048 for the mentoring program to be added later and an \$11,000 increase for Panorama.

Missouri City Schools Presentation

The board invited Theresa McKown, Cassidy Childerston and Tammy Johnson from Missouri City Schools to present on the impact of services currently supported by the CSF. The staff shared about the Happy

Health Homes program. Following the presentation, the Missouri City Schools staff answered questions from the members of the board.

With a second by John McGovern, the board members present voted unanimously in favor of adjourning the meeting.
